As you may know, about three weeks ago, I fell and damaged my right shoulder. It is called "a torn rotator cuff". If the tear is complete, or a total tear from the shoulder, no therapy can heal this injury. Surgery will be necessary.

I do have an appointment with the specialist on March 8th. Maybe an MRI may indicate that surgery, or extensive rehabilitation will repair this injury.

In the meantime, the Bishop has asked Father Emmanuel to come to this parish for the next few weekends.
