The Mass of Chrism

Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in
Grand Falls, NL

On Thursday morning, March 30, 2023 the priests of the Grand Falls Diocese will gather in the Immaculate Conception Cathedral in Grand Falls for our Mass of Chrism. We will gather at the Altar of God with our Chief Shepherd Bishop Daniels. At the Mass, the Bishop will bless the oils used in the Sacraments during the coming year throughout all the parishes in our diocese. The oils to be blessed are the Oil of the Sick (for Holy Anointing), the Oil of Baptism, and the oil called Sacred Chrism which is used at Baptism, in the Sacrament of Confirmation and for the consecrating of a young man in the Priesthood. Representatives from our parishes will receive the Holy Oils and present them to our parish at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday night. The Chrism Mass begins at 11:00 am on Thursday morning. *(Fr.
