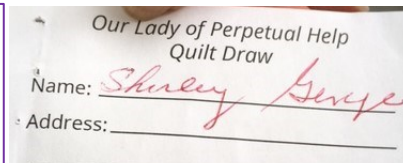

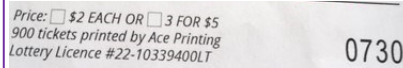
**A Lucky Winner**
