Our Lady of Perpetual Help church, Gambo (1903)

Last evening (Thursday January 12), at our Parish Council Meeting, the members passed a motion to sell the parish Hall and property. With the sale of the hall and property, the Parish Council will use the funds to make repairs and upgrade the church. Council members, Pat Dawe and Bonnie Goulding, will create a steering committee to go forward with the sale.

A few financial facts: In 2021, the Parish spent \$20,051.00 towards the Diocesan Assessment, \$7,053.00 went towards insurance on the three buildings. In addition, \$11,433.80 was spent towards electrical heating and oil for the three buildings. Maintenance repairs for 2021 was \$5,688.45. *(Maurice DeNobrega)*

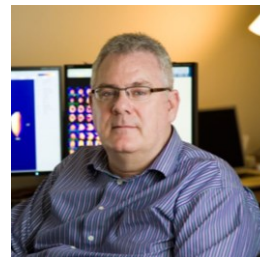
